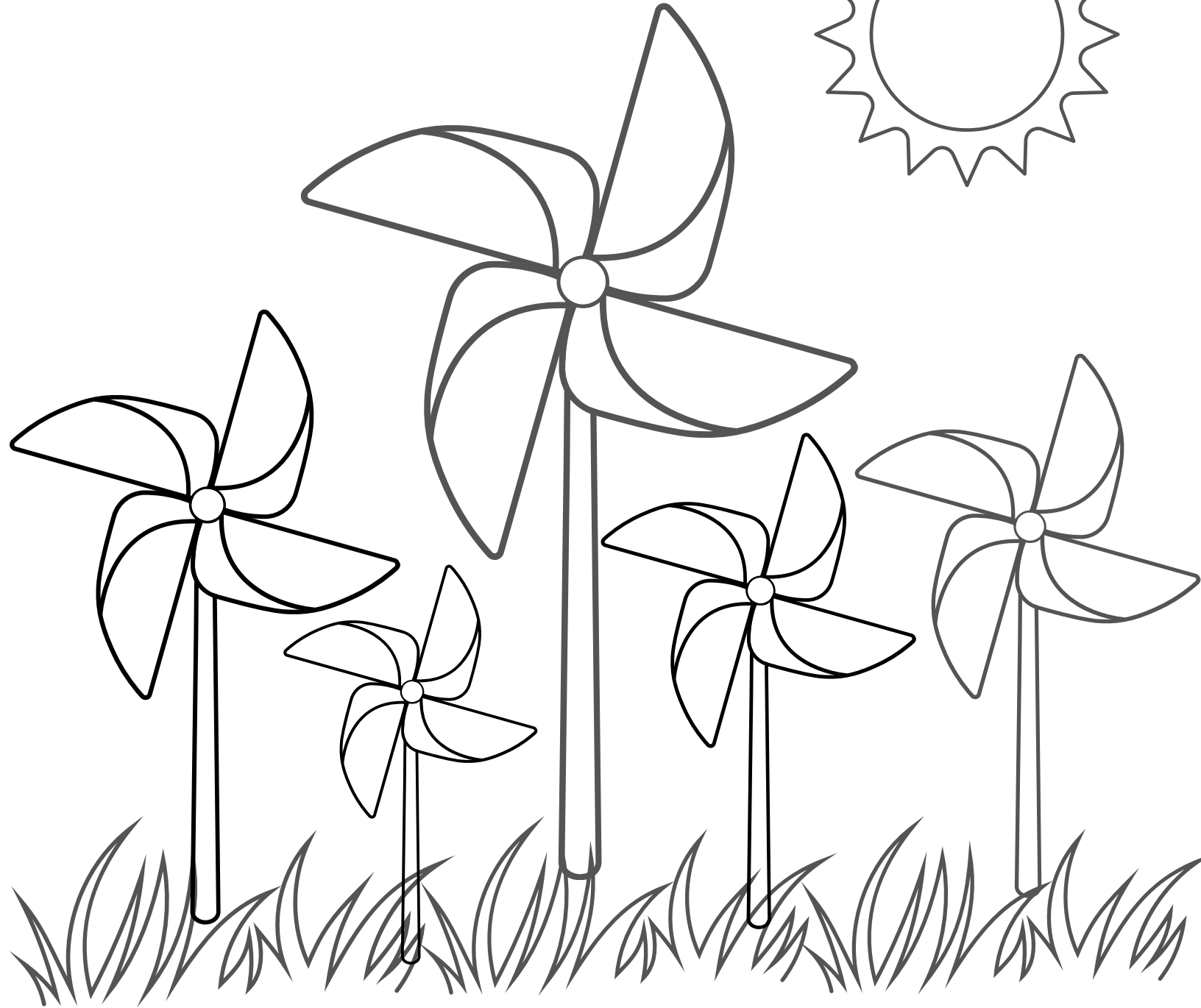
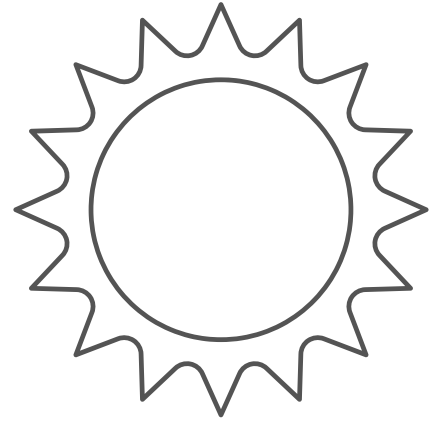


# Pinwheels for Prevention

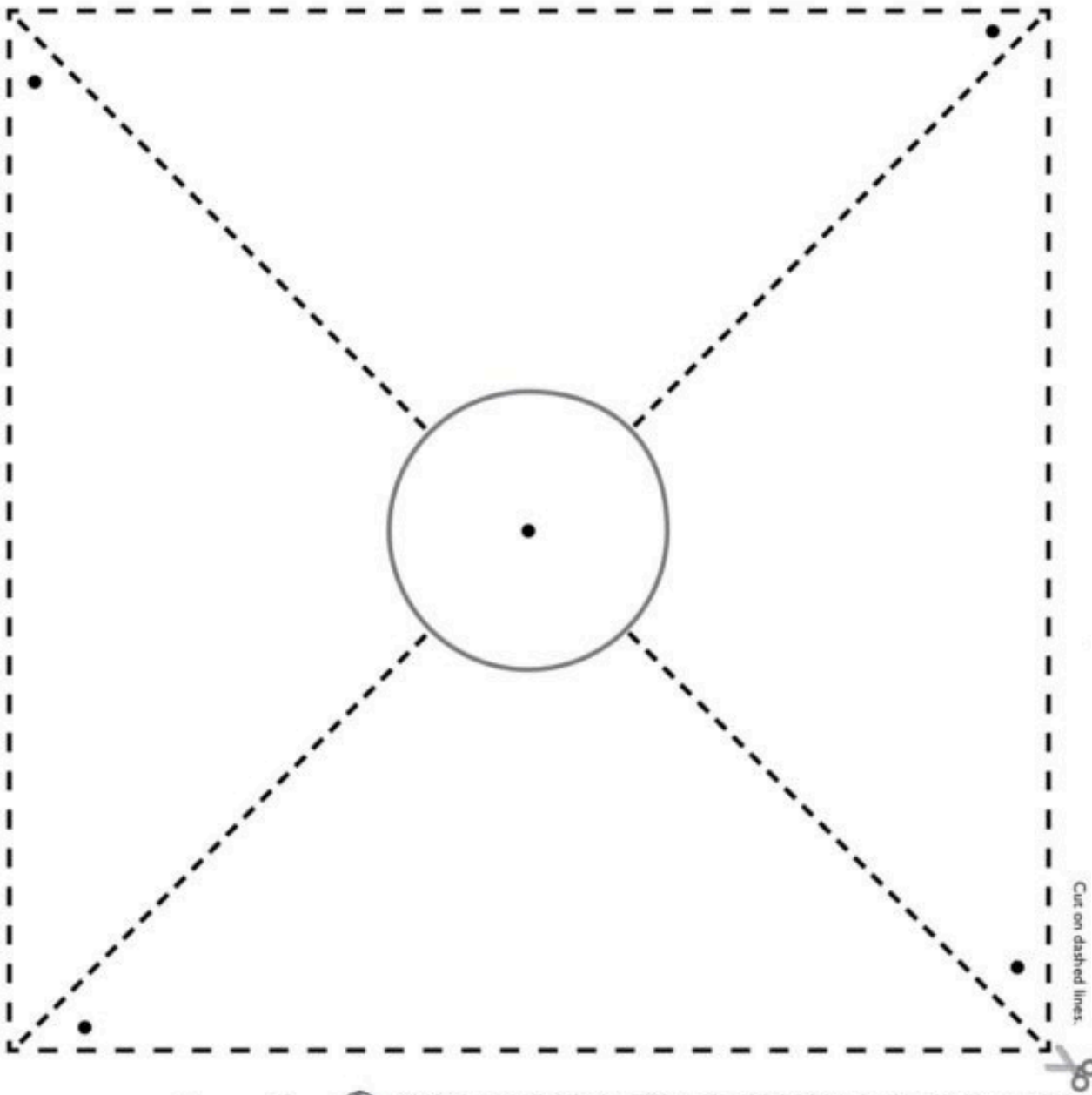
April is Child Abuse Prevention month



## MAKE A PINWHEEL

You need: scissors, a push pin, and a pencil

1. Color both the front and back of the pinwheel sheet.
2. Cut out the pinwheel shape and then carefully cut along the diagonal dashed lines.
3. Use a pushpin to create holes in the center and each of the four corners of the pinwheel. Twist the pin to smooth the holes, helping the pinwheel spin better.
4. Attach the pushpin through each corner, then through the center, and finally into the top of the pencil eraser.



Cut on dashed lines.
